A reorganization meeting of the Planning Board of Shamong Township was held on the above date at the Municipal Building.

Lynn Heinold stated that notice of this reorganization meeting had been published in The Central Record, and notification had also been sent to the Burlington County Times in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Law.

All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

On motion of Mr. Wise, seconded by Mr. Moss, it was moved that Gary Vinciguerra be Chairman for the year 2007. All members present were in favor.

On motion of Mr. Wise, seconded by Mr. Heinold, it was moved that Richard Giberson be Vice Chairman for the year 2007. All members present were in favor.

On motion of Mr. Moss, seconded by Mr. Giberson, it was moved that Lynn Heinold be Secretary for the year 2007. All members present were in favor.

The Secretary informed the other members of the Board that one RFP had been received for Planning Board Attorney, and that was from Peter C. Lange, Esq. On motion of Mr. Heinold, seconded by Mr. Giberson, it was moved that Peter C. Lange, Esq. be the Planning Board's Attorney for the year 2007. All members present were in favor.

The Secretary then informed the other members of the Board that the following engineering firms had submitted RFP's for Planning Board Engineer: Environmental Resolutions, Dante Guzzi, HAKS, Chris Kluk, and Remington and Vernick. The Board discussed the RFP's, and the Secretary was asked to have Dante Guzzi come to the January 23, 2007, meeting for an interview.

On motion of Mr. Wise, seconded by Mr. Heinold, it was moved that Addison G. Bradley be the Land Planner for the Board for 2007. All members present were in favor.

On motion of Mr. Heinold, seconded by Mr. Wise, it was moved that the Planning Board hold their workshop sessions on the third Tuesday of each month, and their regular meetings on the fourth Tuesday with the exception of December when there will be no

workshop meeting, and the regular meeting will be held on the third Tuesday. All members present were in favor.

On motion of Mr. Heinold, seconded by Mr. Wise, it was moved that the Planning Board escrow funds be deposited in any bank doing business in New Jersey where the Township CFO has obtained a Certificate of Governmental Deposit Coverage. All members present were in favor.

On motion of Mr. Heinold, seconded by Mr. Wise, it was moved that the official newspaper be The Central Record, published every Thursday in Medford, NJ. All members present were in favor.

The Chairman was ready to open the meeting to the public; however, no members of the public were present.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
