The Shamong Township Committee held a meeting on the above date at the Municipal Building.

Deputy Mayor Gray called the meeting to order at approximately 7:30 p.m.

Deputy Mayor Gray waived the public comment since there was no public in attendance.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE OFFICIAL ACTION:

On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to approve the minutes of the May 27, 2014 regular meeting. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.

On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to approve the repairs to the snow/plow truck at an approximate cost of \$3900.00. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.

On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to approve the Township Clerk to attend an educational seminar. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.

The Administrator reported she attended a Municipal County Coordination meeting on June 18th with approximately 20 Municipal Administrators. Some of the issues discussed were as follows; looking into any shared purchase opportunities for snow/plow trucks, discussion on a Morris County type purchasing plan/co-op at a cost of \$500 to \$1000 per year to participate, Burlington County now has a form on their web-site specifically for people who want to complain about mosquito problems, Southampton Township

purchased a bucket truck and is interested in shared services for tree trimming, and Tabernacle is in the process of having an ordinance related to vacant properties.

After some discussion the Committee tabled taking any action on membership renewal with the Burlington County Joint Insurance Fund.

On motion of Committeeman Mozitis, seconded by Committeeman DiCroce, it was moved to approve authorization to go out to bid for field light replacement and repairs to the basketball court at Dingtowntown Complex funded by Burlington County Municipal Park Grant Program. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.

The Administrator reported on the following items; Indian Mills Memorial School Graduation is scheduled for 7 pm on Thursday, June 26th at Seneca High School, the 2014 Pine Barrens Festival for Shamong Night if Friday, July 25th, Burlington County board of Health reported a well in the Muskingum Development which tested positive for mercury and six wells from surrounding properties were tested and all were fine, Knights of Columbus conducted a coin drop at the intersection of Oak Shade and Indian Mills Roads on Saturday, June 21st and all went well. The Building Code Official, Court Operation, Finance, and Tax reports have all been submitted. If the Committee has any questions on the reports the Administrator will be glad to answer them.

There was discussion on the meeting date for August and the Administrator will see if it can be changed to August 13th so that all the members can be in attendance.

No public comment.

There being no further business, on motion of Committeeman Mozitis, seconded by Committeeman DiCroce the meeting was adjourned.
