Mayor Long opened the meeting to the public for comment, there being none, he closed the meeting to the public.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE OFFICIAL ACTION:

On motion of Committeeman Gimbel, seconded by Committeeman DiCroce, it was moved to approve the minutes of November 24, 2015 regular and executive session. A roll call vote showed all member present voting yes.

RESOLUTIONS:

On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Gimbel, it was moved to approve Resolution 2015R-86A cancellation of certain general Capital Improvement appropriation remaining balances on completed projects. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.

On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Gimbel, it was moved to approve Resolution 2015R-87 cancellation of unexpended funds. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.

On motion of Committeeman Gimbel, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to approve Resolution 2015R-88 authorizing certain budgetary transfers. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.

ORDINANCES:

The Administrator read Ordinance 2015-8 amending Township Code to create Chapter 136 Governing “Property Maintenance” and opened the meeting to the public. There was no public, so the public hearing was closed. Committeeman DiCroce asked if this would sunset at the end of this year and the Administrator said by the end of 2016. **On motion of Committeeman Gimbel, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to approve Ordinance 2015-8 after second reading and public hearing. A roll call vote showed Committeemen Gimbel, Mozitis, and Long voting yes, Committeeman DiCroce voting no.**

The Administrator read Ordinance 2015-10 Upkeep of vacant and abandoned residential properties and opened the meeting to the public. There was no public, so the public hearing was closed. **On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to approve Ordinance 2015-10 after second reading and public hearing. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes except Committeeman Long who voted no.**

On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Gimbel, it was moved to approve the attached Bill List. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.

Mayor Long opened the meeting to the public for comment, there being none, he closed the meeting to the public.
