On motion of Committeeman Long, seconded by Committeeman Norman, the November 22, 2011 regular minutes were approved. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.

After some discussion on the 2012 mileage reimbursement amount the Committee agreed to the IRS rate per mile. **On motion of Committeeman Gray, seconded by Committeeman Norman, it was moved to follow the IRS suggested rate for 2012. A roll call vote showed Committeemen Gray, Norman and Mozitis voting yes, Committeemen Long and Shevelew voting no.**

The Administrator reported she and Mr. Long reviewed the RFP/RFQ applications and recommend re-appointing the current solicitor and engineer; Mr. Heinold of the firm Raymond Coleman Heinold and Mr. Mannix of the firm Remington Vernick and Arango Engineers. Mrs. Onorato reported they reviewed and interviewed three firms for the auditor's position and recommend Inverso and Stewart for the 2012 appointment. **On motion of Committeeman Gray, seconded by Committeeman Norman, it was moved to appoint the firm of Inverso & Stewart for the auditor's position for 2012. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**

On motion of Committeeman Long, seconded by Committeeman Gray, it was moved to approve Resolution 2011R-149 a salary resolution for STASA. A roll call vote showed all members voting yes except Committeeman Shevelew who abstained.

On motion of Committeeman Mozitis, seconded by Committeeman Norman, the attached Bill List was approved. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.

Mayor Shevelew thanked everyone for their dedication and hard work for the year and looks forward to working with them in the New Year.
