Public Comment

Mayor Shevelew opened the meeting to the public, seeing none, closed the meeting to public comment.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE OFFICAL ACTION:

On Motion of Committeeman Long, seconded by Committee Norman, it was moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of April 26, 2011. A roll call vote all members present voting yes, with the exception of Committeeman Mozitis and Mayor Shevelew who abstained.

On motion of Committee Mozitis, seconded by Committeeman Long, it was moved to appoint Vincent Vendette to the Rent Control board as an Alternate for the remainder of a 2 year term expiring December 31, 2011. A roll call vote of all members present voting yes.

Mrs. Onorato reported on the E-JIF inspection and associated report received

The Township Committee directed the Township Administrator to have the Township Engineer prepare a bid packet for the repair/replacement of the Municipal Building Roof.

Mrs. Onorato reported on the Solar project and informed the Committee that we are facing a delay due to the configuration of the power lines coming in on two separate

meters for the Municipal Building. Renergy, the contractor responsible for the installation has resubmitted the revised documents to Atlantic City Electric and once the approvals are received the project can move forward.

RESOLUTIONS:

Mayor Shevelew read **Resolution 2011R-76**, Refund of an overpayment of taxes as a result of the homestead rebate on block 20.04 lot 11.01. No questions or comments were raised. **On motion of Committeeman Gray, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis: a roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**

Committee reviewed ABC License Renewal for 2011-2012, Certification of the 2010 Annual Audit report, and Approval of 2010 Annual Audit Corrective Action Plan. Presented for future consideration at a later date.

REPORTS:

Mrs. Onorato reported: A storm inlet needed emergency repair at the intersection of Tuckerton Road and Shawnee Lane. Giberson Plumbing and Excavating will rebuild inlet within the next week. Remington & Vernick is seeking estimates to video tape a section of a storm drain creating a sink hole on a property located at 3 Dellett Drive. Atlantic City Electric has notified the Township of their plan to remove small trees and brush, as needed and trim to clear electric lines, as well as top dead trees below lines. All work to be completed by Lewis Tree Service who will chip brush, all wood to be cut up and remain at job site. They should be done within the next week. Attached are the reports from the Building Code Official, Court Administrator and Tax Collector. No questions or comments for the administrator.

Mayor Shevelew opens the meeting to the public for questions or comments, from the public, hearing none, Mayor Shevelew asks for a motion to adjourn the meeting. **On motion of Committeeman Long, seconded by Committeeman Norman: a roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**
