Mayor Long opened the meeting to the public for comments, there being none, he closed the meeting to the public.

**ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE OFFICIAL ACTION:**

**On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Gimbel, it was moved to approve the minutes of the March 25, 2014 regular meeting. A roll call vote showed Committeemen DiCroce, Gimbel, Long, Gray voting yes, and Committeeman Mozitis abstained.**

The Administrator explained the township is required to do a dog census every two years and this has not been done. She said we license approximately 500 dogs a year. The Committee took no action at this time.

**On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Gimbel, it was moved to approve the Tax Collector's request to attend a seminar. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**

**On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to approve the Knights of Columbus coin drop on June 21<sup>st</sup> from 10 am to 2 pm at the Indian Mills Road and Oak Shade Road intersection. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**

### **RESOLUTIONS:**

**On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Gimbel, it was moved to approve Resolution 2014R-47 authorizing and permitting Valenzano Winery to conduct a 5K run. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**

**On motion of Committeeman Gimbel, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, after public hearing Resolution 2014R-48 the 2014 Budget hearing and final adoption was approved. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**

**After some discussion the Township Committee tabled Resolution 2014R-49 support of New Jersey Federal Transportation Program.**

**On motion of Committeeman DiCroce, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to approve OEM for making application to the State for Federal Surplus Property. A roll call showed all members present voting yes.**

### **REPORTS:**

The Administrator reported on the following issues; Senior Day of Service was today and about 7 young men arrived and did a good job of cleaning up around the municipal building, as of April 28<sup>th</sup> all but \$6,187 has been received from Burlington County for Shamong salting and plowing of the County roadways during the 2013/14 winter season, Seneca High School graduation is Friday, June 20<sup>th</sup> at 6 pm, Indian Mills Memorial School graduation if scheduled for Thursday, June 26<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm at Seneca High School, and a reminder that our next meeting is June 10<sup>th</sup> due to the June 3 election. The Administrator also reported shared services with the court seem to be working out very well. This month the township received about \$3,400.

The engineer, Mr. Guzzi, reported on the grant for Safe Streets to School that he was instructed to apply for at the last meeting. Unfortunately there are sections of Grassy Lake Road that are only 16 ½ feet wide so there is not enough room for a walk or bike path unless we acquire land from the homeowners. After much discussion the Committee instructed the engineer to make application for the grant.

Mayor Long opened the meeting to the public at which time Elaine Billmeyer complimented on the terrific job the Public Works employees did during the snow storms. There being no further comments, Mayor Long closed the meeting to the public.

There being no further business, **on motion of Committeeman Gimbel, seconded by Committeeman DiCroce, the meeting was adjourned.**
