Public Comment

Mayor Shevelew opened the meeting for public comment, there being none he closed the meeting to the public.

ITEMS FOR OFFICAL ACTION:

On motion of Committeeman Long, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, It was moved to approve the March 27, 2012 Regular Meeting Minutes. A roll call vote of all present voting yes.

A Review of the 2012 Burlington County Municipal Recreation Grant application was given by Susan Onorato.

Mrs. Onorato reported on the BEMS Municipal Liaison Council requirements for an additional \$250 contribution towards legal representation by Parker McCay. She stated this is the final contribution anticipated to close out this case.

Mrs. Onorato reported on the requirements of approving the proposed Sign Management Plan and reviewed the plans to replace the Township signs over a 3 – 5 year period of time. **On Motion of Committeeman Long, Seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to approve the Sign Management Plan. A roll call vote of all present voting yes, with the exception of Committeeman Gray and Mayor Shevelew voting no.**
