



**U.S. Environmental Protection Agency
Conducting a Review of the Cleanup of the Ewan Property
Superfund Site
Town of Shamong, Burlington County, New Jersey**

The EPA is conducting a five-year review of the cleanup of the Ewan Property Superfund site to ensure that the implemented cleanup continues to be protective of public health and the environment and is functioning as designed. This is the EPA's third five-year review of the cleanup for this site. The EPA will review site operations, maintenance and monitoring information, as well as the status of any land-use controls. The EPA welcomes community input concerning this site, especially any concerns about the implemented cleanup. EPA's cleanup included the excavation of drums and contaminated soils at approved off-site facilities in 1995. A full-scale groundwater extraction, treatment, and recharge system was constructed and operated from late 1999 until June 2006. This system treated contaminated groundwater to applicable standards. The treatment system was then shut down to allow a pilot-scale dual phase extraction (DPE) treatment system to further reduce groundwater contamination within two limited "hot-spot" areas. The DPE system was in operation until April 2012. The potentially responsible parties (PRPs) conducted a limited soils excavation in June 2004. The potentially responsible parties (PRPs) conducted a second limited soils excavation in December 2012. The PRPs perform regular monthly groundwater monitoring, and report findings to EPA and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.
