### **Public Comment**

Mayor Shevelew opened the meeting for public comment, there being no public comment, he closed the meeting to the public.

### **ITEMS FOR OFFICAL ACTION:**

**On motion of Committeeman Long, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to approve the February 28, 2012 Regular Meeting Minutes. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**

The Budget for 2012 was reviewed by the committee and will be introduced at the next meeting on April 3, 2012. The Committee also discussed a review of Trailer Park pad fees which have not been increased since the mid-1990's. Any increase would require an amendment to the current ordinance. The Mayor instructed the Solicitor to draft an Ordinance amendment for consideration. The Township Administrator reported on the need for repairs to township roads, specifically Grassy Lake, McKendimen and other development roads. The Mayor instructed the Administrator to discuss the needs with the Township Engineer, Mr. Robert Mannix and the Public Works Foreman, Mr. Norman Welsh.

**On motion of Committeeman Gimbel, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to approve the 2011 LOSAP Awards of \$22,455.32. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**

Mayor Shevelew appointed Mr. Christopher Boufford to the Joint Land Use Board as a replacement for Mr. Timothy Gimbel for the balance of a four year term.

**On Motion of Committeeman Long, seconded by Committeeman Gimbel, it was moved to approve the Tax Collector and Registrar to attend Education Seminars. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**

Mayor Shevlew directed the Township Administrator to let the Township Solicitor review the Bi-Annual Employee Policy Manual.

**On Motion of Committeeman Long, seconded by Committeeman Mozitis, it was moved to accept the A & T Sprinkler bid for the turn-on and turn-off of the sprinkling systems at Stony Creek ball field and Dingtletown Complex ball fields and any necessary repairs per the quote submitted. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**

### **RESOLUTIONS:**

**2012R-30-Amend Resolution 2012R-23 authorizing donation of FEMA trailer to Burlington County Boy Scout Council. On Motion of Committeeman Mozitis, seconded by Committeeman Long, it was moved to donate the trailer. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**

### **REPORTS:**

Township Administrator reported that the Pinelands Jeep Jamboree is planned for this weekend. Mr. Volpe, will be organizing the volunteers to clean up the walkway/biking area around Dingtletown Complex this Saturday. The Pine Barrens Adventure Ride will take place April 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> and the same weekend is Honda Day at the Atco Speedway. The Administrator reported she had spoken with the NJ State Police, NJ State Parks and Forest Police, and Waterford Township Police to coordinate traffic control of our roads during this event. The solar panels are scheduled to be installed on April 20<sup>th</sup>.

The Administrator informed the Committee that the Building Department had a very good month and she supplied them with copies of the monthly reports for the Construction Office, Tax Office and Court Office.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned **on Motion of Committeeman Mozitis, seconded by Committeeman Long, with all members present voting yes.**
