Minutes of April 21, 2009 Meeting

A regular meeting of the Land Use Board of Shamong Township was held on the above date at the Municipal Building.

The Meeting was called to order at approximately 8:05 P.M. by the Chairman, Mr. Vinciguerra.

The acting Secretary stated that this meeting had been properly advertised in The Central Record, and notification had also been sent to the Burlington County Times, in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Law.

All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The Minutes of the March 17, 2009 Regular Meeting were read and approved as submitted on motion by Mr. Burgin, seconded by Mr. Moss.

Mr. Lange proposed that a motion be made by the Board to appoint Janice L. Heinold, Esquire, as acting Secretary in Lynn Heinold's absence. The motion was moved by Mr. Wise, seconded by Mr. Burgin. All members present were in favor of the motion.

Mr. Lange advised that the Board had two Resolutions to Memorialize. The first was for a bulk variance approval for Nancy Thomas, Block 15.01, Lot 10.02. Mr. Lange read the Resolution. Mr. Wise moved that the Resolution be adopted, seconded by Mr. Burgin. A roll call vote showed Bookbinder Bell, Burgin, Vinciguerra and Wise voting yes. Mr. Moss was not present at the March 17, 2009 meeting, and therefore abstained.

The second Resolution was for a bulk variance approval for Carol Jordan, Block 8.02, 19. Mr. Lange read the Resolution. Mr. Wise moved that the Resolution be adopted, seconded by Mr. Burgin. A roll call vote showed Bookbinder Bell, Burgin, Vinciguerra and Wise voting yes. Mr. Moss was not present at the March 17, 2009 meeting, and therefore abstained.

The acting secretary passed out the New Jersey Planner to the members present and advised the members of an upcoming Site Remediation Seminar in Elizabeth, NJ. The meeting was opened to the public, but no comments were made.
