A regular meeting of the Planning Board of Shamong Township was held on the above date at the Municipal Building.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Mr. Vinciguerra, at 8:00 p.m.

The Acting Secretary stated that in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Law, notification of this meeting had been published in The Central Record, and notification had also been sent to the Burlington County Times.

All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The minutes of the meeting of October 26, 2004, were approved by those members who were present at that meeting. The minutes of January 18, 2005, for the reorganization meeting, were approved after it was noted that Mr. Shevelew was not in attendance at that meeting. The minutes of the work shop meeting of January 18, 2005, were approved as submitted.

The Board reviewed and discussed Ordinances 2005-1 and 2005-2 introduced by the Township Committee. These had also been discussed at the January 18, 2005, work shop meeting. On motion of Mr. Heinold, seconded by Mr. Giberson, it was moved that Mr. Lange send a letter to the Township Committee stating that the Planning Board had reviewed the ordinances and recommended their adoption.

The Board discussed the Stormwater Management Plan that is required to become a part of the Township's Master Plan. After some discussion, it was moved by Mr. Moss, seconded by Mr. Heinold that the Attorney, Engineer, and Land Planner prepare a draft plan for review by the Board and a list of any decisions the Board needs to make in reference to the plan. The Board decided that they would review the draft plan at the February regular meeting.

The Chairman was ready to open the meeting to the public; however, there were no members of the public present.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
