

Shamong Township

A regular meeting of the Planning Board of Shamong Township was held on the above date at the Municipal Building.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Mr. Vinciguerra, at 8:05 P.M.

The Secretary stated that in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Law, this meeting had been properly advertised in The Central Record, and notification had also been sent to the Burlington County Times.

All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

On motion of Mr. Moss, seconded by Mr. Young, the minutes of the meetings of February 21, 2006, and March 21, 2006, were approved as submitted.

The Secretary read a March 28, 2006, letter from Jeffrey I. Baron, Esq., attorney for OakShade, L.L.C, Block 7, Lots 24.04 and 24.05. He asked that the public hearing be continued to the Planning Board's April 25, 2006, meeting in order to give the Board's professionals ample time to review the newly revised major subdivision plans. The Secretary also distributed the plan of the intersection of the proposed road and OakShade Road, dated March 27, 2006. The meeting was opened to the public at which time there were no comments. On motion of Mr. Heinold, seconded by Mr. Moss, it was moved that the public hearing be continued to April 25, 2006, as requested by the applicant. All members present were in favor.

The Secretary informed the other members of the Board that the Township had recently awarded a contract for a cellular receiver and transmitter on a P.S.E.&G. tower located on a Township owned lot. The company that will install and operate the cell facility will be making application to the Township Planning Board for a site plan.

The meeting was opened to the public at which time there were no comments, and the meeting was adjourned.
