**PUBLIC COMMENT** – Agenda Items Only

The meeting was opened to the public for comments, at which time there were none as no public was present, so this portion of the meeting was closed to the public.

**RESOLUTIONS:**

The Solicitor reported that on April 28, 2020, Governor Murphy issued Executive Order 130 which allows the Township to extend the grace period for payment of second-quarter taxes. The Solicitor advised that based on information from the Department of Community Affairs (DCA), it was interpreted that a Resolution would need to be passed by May 11, 2020 in order to comply. It will be reenacted at the upcoming regular Committee Meeting on June 2, 2020. The Clerk advised that if payment was not made by June 1, 2020, interest would be charged going back to May 1, 2020, the original due date. **On motion of Committeeman Gimbel, seconded by Committeeman Cooney, it was moved to approve Resolution 2020R-55 Instituting a grace period concluding on June 1, 2020 for the payment of second-quarter property taxes. A roll call vote showed all members present voting yes.**
